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
Introduction

The Wishing Factory (TWF) is an 80G and ISO certified (ISO 9001:2015), not-for-profit organization dedicated to improving and enriching the lives of young, underprivileged Thalassemia Warriors in India. Our mission is to provide Thalassemia patients with state-of-the-art healthcare facilities and psycho-social support while simultaneously working towards our vision of making India Thalassemia free and raising awareness about the importance of a Thalassemia Test. Since our genesis in 2015, we have expanded our operations to 10 Indian cities impacting 3000+ patients in the areas of Healthcare, Experiences, Education and Patient Welfare Activities. Founded by Mr. Partth Thakur, a Thalassemia Major patient himself, TWF was born with the sole intention of enriching lives and bringing smiles to Thalassemia Warriors. The core belief for us at The Wishing Factory is to touch lives of people suffering from Thalassemia Major and to 'make every life into a lifetime'. Thalassemia though a deadly disorder, is dimly recognised . India has over 3 lakh Thalassemia Major patients and we hope to touch and impact lives of as many as possible in the years to come.

In the past 4 years we have extended medical support to patients residing all over the country through various projects, schemes and Thalassemia Wellness Centres. Patients benefitting from these projects have shown considerable improvement and are now leading a healthier lifestyle. In terms of CSR we have ongoing projects with INOX and IRCTC. We have set up a Thalassemia Wellness center in Vadodara providing free healthcare facilities to patients. Along with this, we have two new wellness centers that have recently been established in Ranchi and Mewat respectively with CSR grants received from IRCTC. A new Blood Transfusion Centre in association with Heubach Color Pvt Ltd will soon be established for patients residing in Vadodara and nearby districts. Various other healthcare projects like Hari Om Scheme, TSS-RBC plan, Good Deeds project etc have also been established in this year to ensure healthcare support is extended to the maximum number of patients.

It is indeed a pleasure to write the fourth editorial of The Wishing Factory magazine. TWF as everyone calls it was built out of a strong urge to do something meaningful in life and perhaps this is because as a child, the fear of not being able to live as much as I wanted - always bothered me.

When we change the way we look at things, the things we look at - change. This year has been an excruciatingly important year for the organization since a lot has happened and changed for the better. We're now determined to do more quality work in the field of healthcare & education that supports patients and also empowers them. We've moved from wishes to experiences which is why we now indulge in fulfilling experiences that shape life for better, like how a 20-year-old Thalassemia Major patient wished to own an oven so that she could start her own home bakery and sell cup-cakes. Well, YOU - made that possible. We really hope that these experiences continue to empower the patients and instill a new surge of confidence in them.

I'm also happy to inform you that we now have 7 Chelation Pump Libraries spread across the country in the cities of Mumbai, Jaipur, Ranchi, Vadodara, Mewat, Warangal, and Pune. With over 80+ pumps distributed across each library, patients continue to achieve tangible reduction in their ferritin and indirectly prolonging life. We're now starting a privately-owned blood transfusion center (inspired by a center in Dubai) in Vadodara. Funded by Heubach Color Pvt Ltd and supported by Dr. Ajay Bhandarkar, this center would be the first of its kind in India and would cater to over 150 blood transfusions every month. Our list of adopted patients has now grown to over 2000+ children with the support of IRCTC, Akshay Kumar, Team Spreading Smiles & Inox Air Products. Our efforts in the area of Awareness broke all records this year after our campaign - Aadhiwali Zindagi Mitao touched 70 Million+ people on World Thalassemia Day. The campaign allowed celebrities like Sonakshi Sinha, Kunal Kapoor, Anil Kapoor, Abhishek Bacchan, Hrithik Roshan, Farah Khan, Raj Kumar Rao and many more to come under one roof and raise awareness for the importance of a Thalassemia Test. Apart from being featured in all the prime newspapers of India, we also received four awards for the overall impact and ideas pertaining to the campaign.

Our efforts towards the education sector continue to impact several patients in the form of scholarships, skill-based workshops, and extra-curricular activity aids. On the sides, this year saw numerous events such as Diwali Parties, Zumba Classes, Yoga Workshops, Dental Camps, Movie Days, etc. merely focussed - to bring smiles. Led by Ms. Neha Nayar, I'm proud and grateful to our new fulltime team that's working tirelessly on our operations and administration from our Dadar Head Office. I'm equally pleased and take this opportunity to welcome Ruena Fernandes & Valeta Lopes as project coordinator's for our head office alongside Mr. Nirav Suru who now looks after Finance and Administration. Along with Priya Vaswani, our newly joined Team Leaders Ritika Parekh & Raj Shah continue to strengthen the presence of TWF in the cities of Pune, Nagpur and Surat. So in closing, I hope you enjoy this year's edition and it fills you in with all the love and good wishes that you have otherwise showered on TWF. I sincerely hope that we do a lot more together such that it stays much beyond our existence.

On hearing what they shared, the teacher was pleasantly surprised as well as felt very satisfied that apart from science her students had learnt the lessons pertaining to life values. She offered her unconditional support in their endeavour. She wanted to be part of it whichever way she could. One of her students was Mr. Partth Thakur, who had come up to her with the idea of establishing The Wishing Factory (TWF), to fulfil the wishes of Thalassemia Major Patients. 



What Is Thalassemia?

Thalassemia is an inherited condition, that is, it is something which is passed on from parents to children in a similar way as parents may pass on other physical characteristics like eye colour or the shape of a nose. Thalassemia cannot be caught or acquired in any other way. Some people are healthy "carriers" of thalassemia. Carriers are perfectly healthy and most do not know that they carry thalassemia. If a man and a woman who are both carriers have children together there is a 25% chance that their baby will be born with thalassemia. The chances are the same with every pregnancy, so a couple who are both carriers are known as a "couple at risk", because each time they have a baby together there is a 25% risk that the baby could be born with thalassemia.



normal blood



What Is The Treatment For Thalassemia?

Thalassemia is a condition which affects the production of red blood cells. Children who are born with Thalassemia cannot make enough healthy red blood cells, so without medical treatment most would get weaker and would fail to develop and grow normally. People with thalassaemia major will need special medical care throughout their lives.

The main treatments are:

Blood Transfusions – regular blood transfusions treat and prevent anaemia; in most cases these are needed around twice a month.


Chelation Therapy – treatment with medicine to remove the excess iron from the body that builds up as a result of having regular blood transfusions.

What If I Am A Carrier?

If your tests reveal that you are a carrier, the health professional will discuss the results with you. You will not develop Thalassemia Major. However, the important point for you is that specifically before planning a family you must get your partner tested at the earliest opportunity. If your partner is not a Carrier you have nothing to worry about. At each pregnancy you have a 50% chance that the child is a Carrier like you and a 50% chance that they are normal and have no Thalassemia Genes. You have no chance of having a child with Thalassemia Major.

Testing And Screening For Thalassemia

A simple blood test can tell you if you are a carrier. This test is called a carrier test for haemoglobin disorders or a "HB Electrophoresis". You should ask your general physician to arrange for you to have this test before you have children, especially if you, your parents or grandparents come from one of the parts of the world where thalassemia is common. The highest risk areas are in the following areas:

We have helped a warrior pursue his dedication for cooking and got him enrolled for a comprehensive cookery course. With this we stand at a wish count of 425 wishes completed. EDUCATION

To ensure holistic development of our patients in all areas of life, we have now started giving out educational scholarships to academically support our warriors. Last year ZIM laboratories from Nagpur gave out education scholarships to 4 of our warriors from Nagpur, Delhi, Mumbai and Pune. Two scholarships were given under our new initiative Educate to Empower, and the contributions were given by individual donors to support patients for their college education. Team Spreading Smiles were a great support and gave out five scholarships this year for our warriors- 3 of which were for education and 2 were for extracurricular skills which included a cookery and Tabla (musical instrument) course. The scholarships were given out to patients from financially deprived classes who have done well in academics and have shown constant progress and continued efforts towards achieving their career goals.

TWF has also tied up with Dr. Reddy's Foundation to train and employ Thalassemia Warriors with basic skills such as communication, mathematics and computers. Patients can get enrolled in the program by registering and paying a minimal training fee for the two month course. On completion of the training module, patients will be offered employment opportunities across various sectors based on their skillset.

This year saw some major developments in the healthcare sector. Although blood transfusions are important for patients, chronic transfusions lead to iron overload in the patients' body. However, advancements in science have significantly changed the prognosis of Thalassemia Major. We now have not only oral iron chelators but also injections that are available and have shown much better results in removing the excess iron from the body. However, the main problem which arises is that the cost of Desferal (the drug used for iron chelation through injections) and the Syringe Pump (medical equipment) is very high which is why most patients cannot afford it. We have established centres in various cities of India.

Patients come to these centres for their Iron Chelation Therapy and to avail various other medical benefits like Blood Filters and Councelling. The environment we created is a friendly and happy place with recreational as well as medical facilities. The centres are well equipped with all necessary healthcare utilities that patients require for their iron chelation therapy. We have also kept various books, games, movies, and toys for the patients so that they can have a more pleasant experience during their chelation sessions. Moreover, various art-based therapies, tuition facilities, skill-based workshops, birthday celebrations, and health-related orientation sessions are regularly conducted at these centres. The Thalassemia Wellness Centre is conceptualised so as to allow patients from economically backward sections of society to avail medical provisions at highly subsidized rates or for free and thereby improving the quality and standard of living in Thalassemia Major patients. It also gives the patients a pleasant atmosphere during their iron chelation sessions that does not remind them of the hospital and the otherwise associated complications with Thalassemia.

INAUGURATION OF THALASSEMIA WELLNESS CENTRE IN RANCHI, JHARKHAND

The following is the impact created by Thalassemia Wellness Centre in Vadodara which is funded by INOX Air Products.

The below statistics represent the outcome of the project:

Serum Ferritin measures the amount of Iron Deposition in the human body. Thalassemia Major patients are advised to check their Ferritin levels from time to time as frequent blood transfusions lead to iron overload in the patient's body.

The mean Ferritin level of patients has dropped down drastically once they started receiving regular medicines under the project as depicted in the table



AWARENESS

We believe that for the eradication of Thalassemia it is very important for each and every person to know more and be aware about this disorder.

Keeping the same objective in mind, Thalassemia awareness sessions were conducted in various places across Pune and Mumbai which included NCMR, Exxat Systems, Ketto, Raheja Universal, Cathay Pacific Airlines and Rotary Clubs in Mumbai. The sessions were immensely interactive and thought provoking, which not only gave a sense of satisfaction to the audience but also to The Wishing Factory, who took this as a great sign for the future of thalassemia patients in India. The Wishing Factory with interactive methods told people about thalassemia and the importance of thalassemia test and blood donation.

An MOU was signed between TWF and Charutar Vidya Mandal to carry out Awareness Sessions, Thalassemia Testing and Blood Camps once a year at all colleges affiliated with them. The entire association was led by our Trustee Dr. Isha from Vadodara.

Our volunteers from Surat, Vadodara and Pune have actively been conducting Awareness Sessions across various schools, colleges and corporate offices to spread the word about the importance of Thalassemia Screening Test.

Our Founder Partth Thakur is a Tedx speaker as well, and has educated a lot of people about Thalassemia as a disorder and the importance of getting the test done. A great milestone we achieved in terms of spreading awareness was the #AadhiwaliZindagiMitao Movement, which saw an unprecedented success rate.

PATIENT WELFARE ACTIVITIES

To ensure overall development of our warriors in all areas of life, we constantly organize skill building and fun-loving activities for them. The activities include sports events, art workshops, personality development activities and fun games and celebrations.

The year started with organizing a friendly cricket match among our warriors from Mumbai, Pune, Surat and Vadodara, called the Viraj Trophy. TWF in association with Piramal Foundation had organized a Mini Carnival for our lovely Thalassemia Warriors in Mumbai. There was dancing, music, magic show and more, and all the patients had an amazing time. We even had an innovative Dance Workshop with Lipsa Acharya - who is a Dance India Dance finalist - conducting the session. The patients did not simply learn a dance routine, but in fact how to let your body free to the rhythm of the music. A visit to Nehru Planetarium and movie screenings happened in Mumbai as well as other cities. There were regular Zumba and Yoga workshops in Pune and Vadodara to encourage our patients to live a healthy lifestyle. The patients got to explore their creative side with our paper quilling workshop in Vadodara and Art workshop in Pune. Oral hygiene is very important, especially for Thalassemia patients, and so we have organized dental camps as well across various cities. We have also tried to make birthdays of our patients a little more special by having birthday celebrations every month.

Meet and Greet sessions were organized with Bollywood actors like Ranveer Singh, Prabhas and Bollywood actress Sonakshi Sinha and Huma Qureshi. The kids enjoyed spending quality time with these famous celebrities. Diwali was celebrated with full enthusiasm across all cities. We conducted Diya painting workshops at Vadodara, Nagpur and Surat followed by card making activities and Diwali Party celebrations with our warriors in Mumbai and Pune. Warriors from Delhi also visited World of Wonders - an amusement park with thrilling rides and adventure.

In the coming year we aim to conduct more life enhancing patient welfare activities across all cities and centres.

Continuing the concept of #AadhiwaliZindagiMitao, pictures of Sonakshi Sinha and Huma Qureshi with their face cropped in half was featured on the first page of newspapers including Indore Times, Surat Times, Baroda Times and Nagpur Times. Again, the idea was to get as many people as possible to get the Thalassemia test done. Our founder Partth Thakur even gave a one-on-one interview that was aired on Radio One and Magic FM.

Another huge success for us this year was when we partnered with Metropolis Laboratories to get the Thalassemia Screening test done at a flat 50% discount. This collaboration was pan India, and anybody could avail this discount at the nearest Metropolis laboratory simply by applying the coupon code. This offer started off on the 8th of May, and is valid till December 2019. TWF collaborated with Unerase Poetry - a community-based platform for promoting spoken word Hindi and English poems. Popular celebrities, Kunal Kapoor and Kubbra Sait recited a poem which highlighted the struggles of patients living with Thalassemia. A similar collaboration was done with Terribly Tiny Tales as well, which is a social media page with a vast following. They put up posts relating to Thalassemia on their page in order to create more awareness.



"The United Kingdom Thalassaemia Society recently hosted Partth Thakur, Founder of the Wishing Factory, at their offices in London. Partth, a Thalassaemia Major patient himself, is an extraordinary human being, having the foresight and dedication from an extremely young age to do his best to change the lives of patients and their families affected by this disorder.

In 2015, at the tender age of 20, Partth single handedly founded The Wishing Factory, a nonprofit organization with the motto **"enriching lives, bringing smiles".** To date, the foundation has managed to fund experiences and events which allowed patients and their families to do just that, enjoy brighter moments, fulfilling wishes in most cases and benefit with treatment options not previously available to many. Four years on, Partth and his team have gone on to set up new treatment centres in the remote areas, providing essential medication and pumps. He was also able to engage the attention of Bollywood superstars for a media campaign which went on to get international recognition.

During his visit to the UK, Partth met with the team at the UKTS and had several discussions on possible collaboration between the two groups. He was also able to visit the thalassaemia unit at Whittington Hospital, which is one of the main centres in the world and meet with the dedicated team responsible for treating some of the world's oldest patients."

Romaine Maharaj, Executive Director of the UKTS has stated that the discussions to date have been excellent and both teams will be launching joint initiatives shortly.







"When, both, husband and wife have thalassemia minor, there are 25 per cent chances that their child will have thalassemia major limiting the life to 30 years. But this can be avoided if people get tests done," said founder and chairperson of TWF Partth Thakur, who is also a thalassemia major. He added that the NGO approached a few celebrities like Sonakshi Sinha, Kunal Kapoor, Huma Qureshi, Kubbra Sait, Manasi Parekh and Patralekha Paul and they all agreed for this campaign.

"The half face in the profile picture on twitter, facebook and Instagram is to remind people to consult a doctor before planning a child," Thakur said adding that with enough awareness of this blood disorder, thalassemia can be completely eradicated as it is a genetic disorder.

Now, thalassemia wellness centre in Jharkhand, Haryana

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VADODARA: Thalassemia patients in Jharkhand and Haryana will soon be able to get their blood transfused for free. With efforts of Vadodarabased NGO The Wishing Factory (TWF), both, Jharkhand and Mewat district will get their first Thalassemia Wellness Centre

TWF, which already operates such centres in Vadodara Pune and Jaipur, will establish

the two new centres with the help of Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC). "The earlier centres of Pune and Jaipur which were also funded by IRCTC received tremendous response so this time IRCTC has released Rs 35 lakh from its corporate social responsibility (CSR) funds," said Partth Thakur, founder and chairperson of TWF. Each centre will come up at a cost of Rs 17.5 lakh, an amount which is higher by Rs 4.5 lakh that IRCTC had given for the earlier centres.

Thakur said that eight chelation pumps costing Rs 2.5 lakh will be given to each centre besides the filters which will cost Rs 4 lakh. "A drug named desferal will alon cost Rs 7 lakh and the remaining amount will be spent for storage facilities and other things," he said.

Last week Thakur signed a memorandum of understanding with district collector of Ranchi Rai Mahipat Ray to establish the centre at Ranchi civil hospital. The centre will be inaugurated on August 25.

Unlike in Vadodara where patients must deposit money to rent the chelation pump, the patients in Jharkhand will be able to get the pumps for free. They will only have to deposit copies of their Aadhar card, electricity bill and ration card or last bill of hospitalization. "Around 367 patients living in Ranchi and 182 from Mewat will directly benefit from it besides other patients from the two states," Thakur told TOI.

"We hope to bring the much-needed attention towards providing healthcare facilities to these patients and thereby enable them to live a healthy life," said CMD of IRCTC M P Mall




